Round 1 Selection Criteria

The following selection criteria will be used to evaluate all Round 1 applications submitted to the *Powering Climate & Infrastructure Careers Challenge*.

CRITERIA	SCORE
1. IMPACT ALIGNMENT Does the proposal present a clear path to deliver uplifting careers, inclusive workforce development and training, and/or effective planning and implementation in climate and/or infrastructure?	1-5
2. SCALE Does the project have adequate reach or potential to impact workers and families at scale to meaningfully contribute to PCIC's goal of impacting 1 million uplifting careers or career pathways?	1-5
3. SUPPORTING UNDERINVESTED COMMUNITIES Are underinvested communities prioritized as part of the project's goals? Does the organization center equity and have leaders who bring lived experience with the problems the project is aiming to address?	1-5
4. LEVERAGE Is the organization well positioned to leverage <i>Challenge</i> funding to raise or impact additional federal funding, private funding, or other investment?	1-5
5. OVERALL ASSESSMENT Reflecting on the overall submission, is this applicant likely to achieve transformational impact and thus should receive strong consideration for funding from the <i>Challenge</i> ?	1-5
